The Spokane Airport Board invites you to bid on the CIPP Sewer Rehabilitation, Project # 19-40-1947. The Scope of work includes but is not limited to: Trenchless rehabilitation of approximately 810 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer pipe, including bypass pumping, temporary traffic control, manhole modifications, Cure-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) installation, associated CCTV inspection, pavement patching, and various other site improvements.

Sealed bids will be received by the Spokane Airport Board at the Spokane International Airport, 9000 West Airport Drive, Suite 204, Spokane, Washington 99224, no later than Wednesday, March 27, 2019 at 2:00 PM. It shall be the duty of each Bidder to submit his/her bid on or before the hour and date specified. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the designated time.
