

## NOTICE OF AIRPORT BOARD MEETING

Tentative Agenda for the July 17, 2014 Board Meeting

# Consent Agenda (Items #1 - #10)

1. \*Approval of Vouchers

Construction Warrant Number 003997 - 004006 \$ 593,495.57 Operational Warrant Numbers 124753 - 125037 \$2,350,754.16

2. \*First Amendment to Insurance Broker Services Agreement – Wells Fargo Insurance Services SIA USA, Inc. – This amendment exercises the first of two options with Wells Fargo Insurance Services effective September 1, 2014. The Airport shall pay an annual fee in the amount of \$37,500. The Finance Committee and staff recommend approval.

- 3. \*Commercial Aviation Ramp Lease and Operating Agreement Associated Painters, Inc. SIA Associated Painters has requested an agreement for 27,063 square feet of ramp adjacent to the ramp that is part of the land lease agreement for the second paint hangar. Associated Painters has entered into a contract with Boeing that will require utilization of the additional ramp. The term of the agreement is five years commencing July 1, 2014. The total annual rent is \$5,682.23. The Finance Committee and staff recommend approval.
- 4. \*Right of First Refusal to Lease Real Property Spokane Turbine Center Spokane Turbine Center submitted a letter of intent to secure Parcel 7 and Parcel 10 for the future expansion of their facility. Construction of a new training center and t-hangars is anticipated to begin in 2016. The Airport will grant a right of first refusal to Spokane Turbine Center effective July 1, 2014. In consideration of the ROFR, STC shall pay an annual fee of \$2,500. The Finance Committee and staff recommend approval.

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- 5. \*Resolution No. 07-14, Authorizing the Submission of Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Application No. 10 to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). Resolution No. 07-14 will authorize the Chief Executive Officer to submit PFC Application No. 10 to the FAA. The application is estimated to extend the authorized collection period of PFCs through February 2019. The Finance Committee recommends Board adoption of Resolution No. 07-14.
- 6. \*Award Construction Contract, Car Wash & Exit Canopy Improvements Graham Construction, Inc. This project involves the construction of a car wash facility and improvements to the existing canopy at the toll plaza. Three bids were received on July 2, 2014. The Engineering Committee recommends award of a contract for construction to Graham Construction in the amount of \$1,498,973 including Washington state sales tax. Staff requests Board authorization of \$150,000 for construction contingencies for a total authorization of \$1,648,973.
- 7. \*Award Construction Contract, Airport Drive Landscaping Improvements Phase III Project SIA Hidden Rivers, Inc. The Engineering Committee recommends award of a contract for construction for the Airport Drive Landscaping Improvements Phase III project to Hidden Rivers in the amount of \$304,360 including Washington state sales tax. Staff requests Board authorization of \$30,000 for construction contingencies for a total authorization of \$334,360.
- 8. \*Professional Services Agreement Renewal for Stormwater Management Services *URS Corporation* In 2011, the Washington state Department of Ecology issued a temporary state waste discharge permit. The work needed to achieve compliance with the permit requirements is performed by a team of three firms led by URS Corporation. This renewal will be the second and final of two renewals of the on-call contract. The Engineering Committee recommends award of a professional services agreement to URS Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$155,448 through August 1, 2015.
- 9. \*Procurement of Glycol Recovery Vehicles *Inland Technologies International, LLC* The Engineering Committee recommends the procurement of three Glyvac<sup>TM</sup> Glycol Recovery Vehicles from Inland Technologies International, LLC, for the total amount of \$1,320,052.80 including all optional equipment, freight charges and Washington state sales tax. The purchase will be fully funded by passenger facility charges.
- 10. \*Procurement of Proximity Card Readers and Associated Equipment Aronson Security Group

  The existing card readers and badge printers have reached the end of their useful life. The
  Engineering Committee recommends approval to purchase 157 new proximity card readers, 2,000
  proximity cards and two badge printers for the amount of \$48,708.58 including all specified options,
  freight and Washington state sales tax.

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11. **Buildings 1 & 2 and Land Lease Agreement** – *Washington State Community College District 17* – The land lease agreement with Spokane Community College to operate an aviation maintenance training program expired in 2008. SCC has been re-evaluating the program and has determined to continue the program at Felts Field. The term of this agreement is ten years, with four five-year options, commencing July 1, 2014. The annual rent for the initial five-year period is \$76,446.24 less tenant improvement credit of \$25,000 for a total annual rent of \$51,446.24. The Finance Committee and staff recommend approval.
