Sealed bids will be received by the Spokane Airport Board at the Spokane International Airport, 9000 West Airport Drive, Suite 204, Spokane, Washington 99224, until **2:00 pm, Tuesday, August 23, 2016** for:

**EDS UPGRADES AND CBRA IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT #12-34
AT
SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

It shall be the duty of each Bidder to submit his/her bid on or before the hour and date specified. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the designated time listed above. Any bids received after the time for opening cannot, and will not be considered.

A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference will be held in the Board Room of the Spokane International Airport Administrative Offices at **1:00 pm, Tuesday July 26, 2016**. Major subcontractors are encouraged to attend; however, it is mandatory for Prime Contractors only. Any bid submitted by a firm, which did not attend this pre-bid conference, will be rejected. A site tour will follow the Pre-Bid Conference.

The general nature of the Work is as follows:

- The Work includes furnishing, installing, and modifying new and existing conveyors and controls in Terminal A1, A2 and A3 CBRA areas as well as addition of a redundant crossover conveyor interconnecting the A1 screening matrix to the A3 screening matrix. Concourse C work includes demolition of the existing CBRA and reconstruction of a new CBRA conveyors and controls. Temporary ticket counter tie-ins to the existing claim device are required along with coordination with TSA for implementing a lobby screening solution during construction. Associated with the Work are wall openings and new walls, electrical lighting, sound baffles, camera relocations, new TSA screening tables with PTRI monitors.

Qualifications and Experience: The Bidder, if self-performing, or its proposed subcontractor for each of the following components of work must demonstrate the minimum required experience and must have successfully completed, within the last five years, similar work as specified in the Qualifications Statement Specifications Section 00309 for BHS Integration, BHS manufacturing, BHS mechanical installation, BHS electrical installation and BHS controls. Failure to complete Section 00309 for all of the firms proposed to complete each of the work components described above, or the failure to demonstrate the required minimum experience, may cause the Bidder to be considered non-responsive or unqualified and the Bid rejected. The Owner reserves the right to request any additional supporting documents deemed necessary after the Bid opening regarding the Bidder's previous work experience.

A contract according to the General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, and Addendums (if applicable) shall be signed prior to work commencing. Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check or surety bid bond, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid for all bid schedules (including sales tax). A performance bond, payment bond, and liability insurance in accordance

with the contract documents will be required for the Contract. This is a prevailing wage project per applicable State Law.

The Spokane Airport Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality, to accept any alternate bids, and to make such award that it deems to be in the best interest of the Airport pursuant to the terms of the Instruction to Bidders and General Conditions. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. All bidders are cautioned to be aware of the requirement to have their bids considered responsive.
