Major subcontractors are encouraged to attend; however, it is mandatory for Prime Contractors only. Any bid submitted by a firm, which did not attend this pre-bid conference, will be rejected.

Sealed bids will be received by the Spokane Airport Board at the Spokane International Airport, 9000 West Airport Drive, Suite 204, Spokane, Washington 99224, no later than Tuesday, February 26, 2019 at 2:00 PM. It shall be the duty of each Bidder to submit his/her bid on or before the hour and date specified. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the designated time. Any bids received after the time for opening cannot, and will not be considered.
