SPOKANE AIRPORTS ANNOUNCES 4th ANNUAL NEIGHBOR DAY OPEN HOUSE AT HISTORIC FELTS FIELD

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane Airports announced Felts Field Airport will be hosting 4th Annual “Neighbor Day Open House” from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Saturday, June 7, 2014. The event is free and open to the public. Event participants will have antique, vintage, homebuilt “kit,” and contemporary planes based at Felts on static display. Some of the more rare and interesting aircraft include the world’s only flying Boeing-40, the restored 1930s era Stearman biplanes that are often seen in the sky above Spokane, and a T-6, which was the final training aircraft used by military pilots in WWII before stepping up to true fighter aircraft like the P-51 Mustang. Also, commercial operators such as Northwest MedStar’s emergency medical aircraft will be on site. More importantly, pilots will be on hand to talk with visitors regarding their aircraft.

The event’s primary coordinator is the Spokane Chapter, Club No. 79 of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA). The Spokane Chapter arranged for the Historic Flight Museum’s restored DC-3, which is based at Everett’s Paine Field, to fly-in for the Open House. Ground tours of the DC-3 are also available with a suggested donation of \$5 per person. DC-3, biplane, and helicopter rides will also be available for purchase.
