The Spokane Airport Board announces its intent to award the contract on Thursday, February 19, 2026 for:

This Notice of Intent to Award is subject to the completion of a protest period and the execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the Spokane Airport Board and the apparent successful contractor.

A protest shall specify the reasons and facts upon which the protest is based and shall be filed in writing with the Airport no later than two (2) business days from the date of this notice. The Airports Protest filing process will be provided upon request. By filing a protest, the claimant filing represents and warrants that the entity has not lobbied, discussed, or otherwise engaged in any communications with regards to the protest, and will refrain from the same, with any member of the Airport Board of Directors, Airport Chief Executive Officer, Airport Project Manager, or any other Airport officer, employee or representative. Such lobbying, discussion or communications shall constitute a waiver of the claimant's ability to pursue a protest.

The contractor shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the contract until a contract containing terms and conditions acceptable to the Spokane Airport Board is executed. If the apparent successful contractor fails to execute a contract with the Spokane Airport Board for any reason, the Spokane Airport board may revoke the award and award the contract to the next apparent successful contractor, reject all bids received for the project, or withdraw the Request for Bids. The Spokane Airport Board further reserves all legal or equitable rights related to Request for Bids, including but not limited to the right to revoke and/or cancel this Notice of Intent to Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.
