Dividing the weighted DBE totals by the total estimate for all trades gives a base DBE availability figure for the projects anticipated during the goal-setting period. This figure is expressed as a percentage and serves as the basis for the three-year overall goal.

Base of DBE Goal: 1.73%

Step 2. The 2019 Washington State Disparity Study recommends a Step 2 adjustment related to DBE business formation rates, as indicated in the Disparity Study. For this adjustment, the data sources used for Spokane International Airport are from the business formation rates of Black (3.1%), Latino (4.5%), Native American (4.2%), Asian/Pacific Islander (8.8%), Other (4.3), White Women (10.2%), and Non-White Males (6.5%) in the construction industry; and Black (0.9%), Latino (5.0%), Native American (0.0%), Asian/Pacific Islander (3.3%), Other (0.0%), White Women (5.3%), and Non-White Males (4.5%) in the construction-related services industry. For the Step 2 adjustment, the average value of the above data sources (**4.3%**) was averaged with the Step 1 figure of **1.73%** to come up with an overall goal of **3.02%**.

Breakout of Estimated "Race and Gender Neutral" (RN) and "Race and Gender Conscious" (RC) Participation

Spokane International Airport will meet the maximum feasible portion of the overall goal by using RN means of facilitating DBE participation. RN means are project dependent and may include:

- 1. Arranging solicitations, times for the presentation of bids, quantities, specifications, and delivery schedules in ways that facilitates DBE, and other small businesses, participation;
- 2. Providing assistance in overcoming limitations such as inability to obtain bonding or financing;
- 3. Providing technical assistance and other services;
- 4. Carrying out information and communications programs on contracting procedures and specific contract opportunities;
- 5. Implementing a supportive services program to develop and improve immediate and long-term business management, record keeping, and financial and accounting capability for DBEs and other small businesses:
- 6. Providing services to help DBEs and other small businesses improve long-term development, increase opportunities to participate in a variety of kinds of work, handle increasingly significant projects, and achieve eventual self-sufficiency:
- 7. Establishing a program to assist new, start-up firms, particularly in fields in which DBE participation has historically been low;
- 8. Ensuring distribution of DBE directory, through print and electronic means, to the widest feasible universe of potential prime contractors;
- 9. Assisting DBEs and other small businesses to develop their capability to use technology and conduct business through electronic media.

Spokane International Airport estimates that in meeting the established overall goal of **3.02**%, it will obtain **0.6**% from RN participation and **2.42**% through RC measures.

This breakout is based on: The median value of actual past participation for awards and commitments is 0.6%. (FY21: 0.8%, FY20: 0.4%, FY18: 0.02%, FY17: 1.7%)

Spokane International Airport will adjust the estimated breakout of RN and RC DBE participation, as needed, to reflect actual DBE participation (see §26.51(f)) and track and report race neutral and race conscious participation separately. For reporting purposes, RN DBE participation includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following: DBE participation through a prime contract obtained through customary competitive procurement procedures; DBE participation through a subcontract on a prime contract that does not carry a DBE goal, DBE participation on a prime contract exceeding a contract goal, and DBE participation through a subcontract from a prime contractor that did not consider a firm's DBE status in making the award.

Consultation

In establishing the overall goal, Spokane International provided for consultation and publication. This process included consultation with minority, women's, and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the Spokane International's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs. The consultation included a scheduled, direct, interactive exchange with as many interested stakeholders as possible focused on obtaining information relevant to the goal setting process, and was conducted before the goal methodology was submitted to the operating administration for review. Details of the consultation are as follows.

The consultation engaged in was a teleconference, which was held via Teams at 2:00 p.m. on September 1, 2020.

For FAA-funded projects, DBE's will be targeted by advertising projects for 7 days, during the pre-bid meetings, notifying the bid-holder list, and outreach to local DBE groups.

For FAA-funded projects, goals will be established for construction and design portions of projects. Informational meetings will aid in providing project details for professional services.

DBE goals are established if the cumulative total value of prime contracts exceeds \$250,000 in FAA funds in a federal fiscal year.
