Sealed bids will be received by the Spokane Airport Board at the Spokane International Airport, 9000 West Airport Drive, Suite 204, Spokane, Washington 99224, until **2:00 p.m. PST, November 10, 2020** for:

EDS MACHINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, #17-44-1908 AT SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

It shall be the duty of each Bidder to submit his/her bid on or before the hour and date specified. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the designated time listed above. Any bids received after the time for opening cannot, and will not be considered.

A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference will be held in the Airport Event Center of the Spokane International Airport at **2:00 p.m. PST, October 14, 2020**. The Pre-Bid Conference will be hosted onsite as well as virtually. Major subcontractors are encouraged to attend either onsite or virtually; however, attendance (in person or virtual) is mandatory for the Prime Contractors only. Please limit attendance to one person per firm. Pursuant to Washington State Department of Health Order 20-03, it is mandatory to wear facial coverings when inside the Spokane International Airport terminal and other airport public areas. Bid Proposals submitted by a contractor, which did not attend this pre-bid conference, will be rejected.

The general nature of the Work is as follows:

The Work includes providing, modifying and installing new conveyor and associated controls equipment to support the recapitalization of the existing EDS screening machines throughout Concourse A&B, and C (5 total machines). This includes providing temporary portering of checked baggage during modifications to the systems. Checked Baggage Screening Area will remain in operation during construction to neighboring systems. Concourse C requires a temporary Checked Baggage Screening Area in the lobby, included as part of scope of work.

A contract according to the General Conditions, General Requirements, and Addendums (if applicable) shall be signed prior to work commencing. Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check or surety bid bond, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid for all bid schedules (including sales tax). A performance bond, payment bond, and liability insurance in accordance with the contract documents will be required for the Contract. This is a prevailing wage project per applicable State Law.

The Spokane Airport Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality, to accept any alternate bids, and to make such award that it deems to be in the best interest of the Airport pursuant to the terms of the Instruction to Bidders and General Conditions. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. All bidders are cautioned to be aware of the requirement to have their bids considered responsive.
