1. Disclaimer:

- a. Q&A is not binding until issued in written addendum
- 2. Project Overview:
 - a. 3 year or \$50K Unit Price (on-call) Auto Door and Glass Repair at various Airport locations through the issuance of Task Order as ordered by the Airport.

3. Important dates

- a. Bidders Check list
 - i. <u>Submission of Questions</u> Friday, October 09, 2020 at 2:00 PM All questions from this point forward must be in writing or email.
 - ii. <u>Responses to Questions</u> will be provided no later than <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October</u> 13, 2020 4:00 PM via an addendum.
 - iii. Bid/Quote due date Thursday, October 15, 2020 at 2:00 PM.
 - -This is different from the Bid documents and will be officially changed through the addendum issuing the notes of this meeting.
 - -Public opening will be held at the Ground Transportation Center shortly after close of the bidding.
 - -Mail or turn in bid at the Airport Reception desk, Main Terminal, Suite 204 for date/time stamp.

4. Important Items

- a. Unit Price On-call work is Public Works job, prevailing wage is required. *Per RCW* 39.12.120, weekly certified payroll reports are required to be filed online with L&I at least once a month for all public works projects.
- b. Effect July 1, 2019, L&I require contractors to have Public Works training prior to bidding. If your company is not exempt or has not had this training, you will be deemed non-responsive. For further questions, please contact L&I.
- c. Retainage Five percent (5%) retainage will be withheld until the end of each contract year.
- d. A 5% Bid Security is required in the form of a bond or cashier's check only
- e. Certificate of insurance requirement is \$1M due to airfield escorting
- f. Bid Proposal Form §1.10 Liquidated Damages:
 - a. If the work is not substantially complete within specified Work Order Time, Liquidated Damages as defined by the General Conditions will be assessed in the amount of \$250.00 per calendar day.
- g. Although the Bidder's Checklist is not required to turn in with your bid, it is an excellent tool to ensure you have a complete and responsive bid.
- h. Addendums will be posted within the SIA web site. Additionally, an email will be send to those on the sign in sheet from this meeting.

- 5. Review of Scope of Work (SOW):
 - a. This Unit Price (UP) contract replaces the Preventative Maintenance (PM) contract in its entirety.
 - b. Work is assigned by work order. See bid docs for specifics.
 - c. Glass and mirror replacement is added to the scope of work.
 - d. May have more repair calls than were normal under the PM.
 - e. Badging is required but contractor will be escorted when driving on the secured side of the Airport.
